

Get Ready Now.

Develop your own incident plan



Make sure your vehicle has fuel



Pack a comprehensive emergency kit



Prepare your house & surrounds



When to Leave? Early!

When you hear an incident will impact your area



When advised by RFS, SES, Police, FRNSW, ABC radio



Close windows, doors, turn off gas & water



Notify family and friends when you leave



Do not rely on electricity supply to fight fires.

Do not drive through smoke or flood waters.

Where to Go?

Only if you can't execute your plan.

In case of Bushfire the designated Neighbourhood Safer Place is the Open Area at Snug Cove.

For all other events listen to direction from Emergency Services.

Note: Evacuation Centres will only be opened and staffed at the direction of the Local Emergency Services.

Remember that not all areas can cater for animals.

What to Expect?

No staff or emergency services

Limited Visibility

Crowds

Limited Access

Loss of Power and Communications

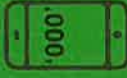

Where to Go?

Leaving early is always the safest option. Emergency Evacuation Centres will only be activated under direction of Emergency Services.

Barclay Street Precinct is the nominated evacuation centre for Eden but may not be suitable in all eventualities.

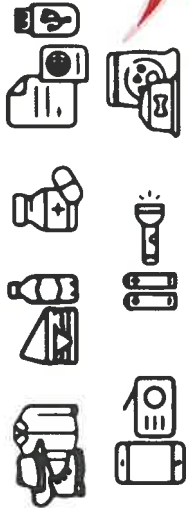
At an evacuation centre you may find: Immediate emergency relief: this may include food and water, first aid and personal support. They *may not* be suitable for animals.

Other designated locations within the Bega Valley Shire: **Merimbula** (Club Sapphire). **Bega** (Showground). **Bermagui** (Surf Lifesaving Club).

In the event of Bushfire RFS Neighbourhood Safer Places are a **LAST RESORT** if your personal plan has failed.

Eden (Snug Cove) carparking, toilets **Boydton** (adjacent to Seahorse Inn) camping, power, EV charging, water

What to Take?



What to take: Protective clothing - hat, long-sleeved top, pants, sturdy footwear, food and water, prescriptions, medications, toiletries, phone, charger, radio, torch (and batteries), important documents, photos, insurance, USB sticks, pets and pet needs.
